Admission fee: \$250 per participant per semester. Application deadline: September 10, 2020. Admission fee for fall: Payable by sept 15, 2020. Admission fee for spring: Payable by January 15, 2021

12 class sessions each semester. Class sessions using zoom every Sunday 9.30 am-11.30 am with 10 minutes recess 10.20-10.30 am.

The fall semester classes start September 20th, ending on December 6th (Sundays); the spring 2021 semester classes starting February 7th and ending on April 25th, 2021 (Sundays).

Eligibility: early elementary (gr.1-2); elementary (gr. 3-5); middle (gr. 6-8); and high (gr. 9-12). YHS summer online Hindi program 2020 students get priority in enrollment. Prior knowledge of Hindi not required. Strongly recommended: practice reading, recognizing and writing Hindi alphabets prior to program.

Theme: storytelling (motivational and cultural stories from India). Curricula: based on the backward design principles, Actfl proficiency guidelines, Startalk best practices. The theme, 'storytelling', a continuum in the spring semester.

Program goals: improve proficiency in speaking, reading and writing Hindi; learn India's culture, traditions, history and geography; real life conversation

Classroom activities in three modes (interpretive, interpersonal, presentational): interpret and analyze cultural products, practices, and perspectives (interpretive); discuss, deconstruct and debate (interpersonal); individual presentation of stories (presentational).

Certificates: certificate of participation indicating number of instruction hours will be issued to all successful candidates. (a successful candidate will attend all sessions and activities.)

Why a twin semesters program?

The twin semester program helps continued Hindi learning; foreign language credits; seal of biliteracy.
