Meet Musicians at Children's Concert-in-the-Round Nov 12

Children ages 4 to 12 will have the opportunity to enjoy the world of Baroque chamber music at the Lenape Chamber Ensemble's 'Concert in the Round' on Saturday afternoon, Nov. 12th at 2:00 P.M. in Doylestown.

Children's Concerts in the Round are held in the Life Sciences Building Auditorium at Delaware Valley University, 700 East Butler Avenue, in Doylestown and are a regular presentation of the Lenape Chamber Ensemble in the fall and spring.

The celebrated chamber musicians who will perform Baroque favorites on Friday night, November 11th at the adult concert in Upper Black Eddy, Pennsylvania, will bring to the children excerpts from the program of Vivaldi, Bach and Leclair for two violins, viola, cello, bass and harpsichord. Violinists Katie Hyun and Elizabeth Pitcairn will play solo excerpts from Vivaldi's Four Seasons and the Leclair Violin Concerto op 7, No. 5. All five string players will entertain the children with their inspirational personalities during the question/answer session. Lionel Party who has been heard many times as harpsichord soloist with the New York Philharmonic will demonstrate his skill with Bach's "Italian Concerto" for solo harpsichord. Then the children may come on stage to view the instruments and chat with the musicians. Moderators for the 45-minute program will be Violinist Katie Hyun from New York's Trinity Baroque and cellist Alberto Parrini from the American Symphony.

The Concert-in-the Round is in the Life Sciences Building Auditorium at Delaware Valley University, 700 East Butler Avenue, in Doylestown. To access the parking lot take the State Street exit off Route 611 bypass and turn left onto New Britain Road.

Admission is \$2.00 for each child at the door. Parents and adults accompanying the children will be admitted free. "Concerts In the Round" are supported by a grant from the Pennsylvania Partners in the Arts, a division of the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts Visit Bucks County and the Upper Bucks Community Foundation.
